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Base Access Pass: All individuals, 16 years or older who do not have a civilian or military ID card will require a base access pass. Everyone that needs a pass is required to fill out and submit a Department of the Navy local population ID card/base access pass registration form (SF 5512/1). This form can be found online: media.defense.gov or go to our website: hawaiiusbc.org or contact Hawaii USBC and we will email it to you. Forms should be submitted, no later than, three weeks before the tournament date.

Rule 2: The team captain will check-in the entire team 60 minutes prior to the scheduled bowling time for the Team Event. All bowlers in the Doubles and Singles Events must check in 6 C minutes prior to bowling time.
**NDTE: Team captains checking in for the team must present a current USBC adult membership card for each bowler on the roster. If current membership cannot be verified, a membership card must be purchased ( $\$ 25$ ) at the tournament site.

Rule 13: Entries will be scheduled according to requests, if possible, and in the order received. The Tournament Director, except for emergencies, will not change the schedule. The Tournament Director will assign lanes for each event. Each event will be bowled on one pair of lanes. The lineup will be the same as shown on the entry form.

Any player or team arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score(s) will count beginning in the frame that's being bowled. ND SCDRE WILL BE GIVEN FDR FRAMES MISSED, per USBC Rule 32Za.

The Doubles Event will be bowled first, followed by the Singles Event. Both events will be bowled on the same pair of lanes. If a scheduled bowler has not arrived in time for the Doubles Event and a substitute is not available, the scheduled bowler's partner will be permitted to bowl their games in the Doubles Event to qualify for All-Events.
Any protest affecting eligibility ar general playing rules must be confirmed in writing to the Tournament Director before the tournament prize distributions are made. Errar in scoring must be

Rule 17: Prizes will be paid for handicap scores with at least one (I) prize for every seven (7) entries. Prize checks will be mailed to the team captains within 30 days after the tournament has closed. The captains shall distribute the checks within 15 days after receipt.

## **NDTE: PRIZE CHECKS MUST BE CASHED WITHIN SO DAYS. CHECKS WILL NDT BE REISSUED. *

**NDTE: Rule 319d of the 2023/2024 Playing Rules will not apply for this tournament.
DPEN ENTPY FEE: $\$ 400$ per team ( $\$ 10 \mathrm{Cl}$ per bowler). [Fee breakdown per bowler: Team Event: $\$ 30$, Doubles Event: $\$ 30$, Singles Event: $\$ 30$, All-Events: $\$ 10$.
DPTIONAL SCRATCH ENTRY FEE: \$200 per team (\$50 per bowler). [Fee breakdown per bowler: Team Event: \$14, Doubles Event: \$14, Singles Event: \$14, All-Events: \$8.]
FORMAT: The tournament shall consist of a four-person Team Event, a Doubles Event, and a Singles Event. Three consecutive games shall be bowled in each event and total pins with handicap shall decide the winner. The Doubles Event will be bowled first followed by the Singles Event. The Doubles Event cannot be bowled without the Singles Event, and vice-versa. The total of nine games bowled with handicap shall determine the All-Events winner.

Optional Scratch Division will be open to all participants who have entered and paid the fees for the regular handicap tournament (Teams, Doubles, Singles, \& \& games All-Events) and wish to pay the fees for the Dptional Scratch Division. For the Scratch Doubles Event both partners must enter. For the Scratch Team Event all bowlers on the handicap team roster must enter.
Multiple participation will be allowed for the Team Event only. At least two (2) bowlers must be changed from a team lineup to be considered a new entry. The first score bowled in any event will be used for an individual's sll-Events total.
**NOTE: No multiple participation will be allowed for Doubles or Singles Events.
AVERAGES: Averages for the tournament shall be the highest certified average from the following sources:
A. Highest USBC certified Standard Composite average based on 21 or more games from...
$\begin{array}{lll}\text { 1) } 2023-2024 \text { season } & \text { 2) } 2022-2023 \text { season } & \text { 3) } 2021-2022 \text { season }\end{array}$
B. For bowlers who only have sport or challenge averages the USBC adjustment scale will be used.
C. Highest completed average on file ar current average of 21 games or more as of May 17 . 2024 . (It is the bowler's respansibility to provide a current league standing sheet with the entry form to verify average).

## **NDTE: Only current averages from USBC certified leagues will be cansidered.

D. Previous season's highest average from another association based on 21 games or more as verified on Bowl.com.
E. If none of the above applies, entrant will use a scratch entering average of 200 .

The tournament committee reserves the right to re-rate any bowler entering this tournament. The adjustment scale is not considered a "re-rate". The purpose of the adjustment scale is to allow for a fair adjustment to what would be expected of the bowler on a standard condition. The adjustment scale does not supersede the Tournament Director's ability to further adjust upward any bowler's tournament entering average per USBC Rule 319c.

Handicap will be based on IICO\% of 200, using USBC tournament calculation format.
No refunds will be made after entries have been received and dates assigned by the Tournament Director. Entry fees should be paid by cash, check, or money order. Make checks payable to "Hawaï ISBC". FULL ENTRY FEES MUST ACCDMPANY THE ENTRY FDRM. Any checks returned ar not honored by a financial institution will be assessed a \$30.00 service handling fee. Full payment, including the assessed fee, must be made (cash or money order) within IO days of notification.
Substitutes will be allowed if necessary. The Tournament Director should be advised of any substitutes at least one hour before the scheduled bowling time, if possible. Substitutions may be permitted after a game has started for the Team and Doubles Events. However, once a player is removed, they cannot return to bowl for the remainder of the event. No substitutions may be made after the series has started for the Singles Event. Scores bowled through the efforts of more than one individual shall not qualify for any USBC or tournament individual awards, nor shall the score be included in the All-Events total.
reported to the Tournament Director within 24 hours.
In the case of a tie in any event, winners will be declared Co -Champions. The prize monies for the tie will be divided equally.

Food and beverages may be consumed in compliance with the respective bowling center's guidelines. Any bowler who appears to be ar becomes, intaxicated, "under the influence", uses abusive language, obscene gestures, or who delays the normal process of the game shall be immediately removed from the tournament and the score will be zero (D) for any remaining frames of the game.

Bowlers are required to wear suitable attire. Example of prohibited attire include, Hats (medical reasons only), biker shorts, biker pants, leggings, tank tops, sleeveless shirts, shirts with inappropriate graphics/language, halter taps, bare midriffs, spaghetti strap tops, workout attire, short-shorts*, short-skirts*, short-culottes*, bib overalls, torn jeans, cutoffs, etc.
*The length of these items (shorts, skirts, culottes) must ga beyond the fingertips when your arms are at rest along your sides.
The use of an artificial hearing device (headphones, etc.) to listen to music ar a broadcast is prohibited during competition.
The tournament shall be conducted in accordance with the USEC rules governing local association tournaments and the USBC general playing rules in addition to the rules adapted by the association. The Board of Directors of the Hawaii USBC shall decide any questions not covered by these tournament rules.
The Board of Directors of the Hawaii ISBC Assaciation shall have the power to hear and act on disputes, complaints or protests relating to the taurnament. The decision of the board is final except when an appeal is made to the USBC. The entrants, whose names appear herean ar their authorized replacements, hereby agree that the Hawaii USBC, its officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change, or premature termination of the tournament, which may be brought about by war, national emergency or emergency of causes relating thereto or resulting therefrom, fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Hawaii USBC.

* Prize checks may be reissued at the discretion of the tournament management on a case-by-case basis.
